### **Funding Success for Compass!**

We are absolutely delighted to share some of the incredible support Compass is receiving. Thanks to the number of funders interested in the project, our 2022 developments are now possible. Watch this space!

The National Lottery (TNL) Community-Led Fund: £150,000 across three years to cover an Outdoor Areas Manager post, a Social Enterprise Manager and support towards the Zero-Waste kitchen development.

The Scottish Government's Community and Renewable Energy Scheme (CARES) Local Energy Scotland 'Let's do net-zero': £74,500 to support the installation of sustainable heating in the multi-purpose hall.

ACVO Communities Mental Health & Wellbeing Fund / Scottish Government: £34,350 to cover dry stone walling training, an accessible toilet, social prescribing coordinator post, polytunnel and more!

**TNL Together for our Planet: £10,000** to assist with the purchase of a composting toilet, shed and gardening equipment.

Green Action Trust (GAT) and Central Scotland Green Network (CSGN) Growing Food Together Fund: £5000 towards the purchase of a composting toilet, shed and gardening equipment.

**ACHCP NHS Food in Focus:** £500 to help us purchase 10 fruit trees and 10 fruit bushes for the community garden.













The interest that Compass has generated confirms the **exciting potential** of such a project delivering a **sustainable initiative** supporting **health and wellbeing of the local community**. The funding will promote a **wide range of new volunteering opportunities** as we continue to drive the project forward.

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### **Buildings**

- Multi-Purpose Hall: Plans have progressed for multi-user access to this building with sustainable heating & lighting due to be installed from Spring 2022 onwards, and we aim to open in Aug 2022.
- Kindergarten / Science Block: Plans to refurbish these buildings and develop into an enterprise / early years / volunteer hub are underway with MAC Architects.

#### **Outdoor Spaces**

- Firewood: Limited seasoned firewood is available on a donation basis from trees felled onsite. Suggested minimum donation of £7.50 for 1 unit (approx.12kg or 1/3 of a wheelbarrow) Get in touch with our project coordinator to organise collection: compass@cwt.scot - firewood is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Composting Toilet: With funding secured for the installation of a composting toilet, we are currently researching the best design for the space we have.


# **Site Safety & Security**

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## **Fundraising**

Phase 1: achieved £200,000

Phase 2: ends September 2023 | Current amount raised: £380,003 | Target: £800,000
