Buildings

- **Main Building:** Further roof repairs recently completed mean the building is now wind and watertight.
- **Multi-Purpose Hall:** Plans continue to progress with sustainable heating & lighting due to be installed from Spring 2022 onwards. We aim to open in Aug 2022.
- **Kindergarten / Science Block:** Plans to refurbish these buildings and develop into an enterprise / early years / volunteer hub are underway with MAC Architects.

• **Community Garden plans:** If you've visited our site recently, you'll see the fantastic progress that our Compass team have made along with support from our volunteers. The first no-dig bed was laid in October 2020 and now we have over 24 in place with additional space ready for the fruit canes and bushes.
