Farewell Svetislav!

Our Outdoor Areas Manager, Svetislav Kondic, will be leaving Compass to return home to Serbia in June. We are very sad to see him go. Slav has made a significant contribution to Compass since he began work in November. His design for the community garden layout which, along with our volunteers, he has recently completed, will be a lasting and growing legacy of his time with us.

To take over from Slav, we are looking to appoint a **Head Gardener / Outdoor Areas Manager** for our National Lottery Community Funded 2.5 year post and invite interested participants to get in touch with us for an application pack.



The role involves **care for all aspects of the 4.1 acres outdoor site**, including its mixed woodland. **Gardening / horticultural / agricultural experience** is required and **experience of beekeeping** is highly desirable. Ability to forward plan with regards to planting and land management is essential as is ability to operate a range of appropriate land management power tools. The deadline for applications is **Friday 3rd June 2022.**

We are also looking for a **Project Manager** to drive the Compass project forward with its growing team. Details of this additional vacancy will be released shortly; keep an eye on our website and Facebook pages for more information.

Bees & Worms

We are pleased to report that Compass' **first bee hive is doing well** having established itself in its new location. The hive has been placed well away from the public route through the site so there should be no disruption when walking on the core path. We look forward to sharing some Compass honey with you later this year.





Our Clinical Lead, Dr Stefan Geider, pictured left, has also introduced a **wormery** to the Compass site to support the project's **biodynamic, organic growing** principles.

The worms work across a number of layers inside the barrel to **breakdown the food waste and leaves** we add to it. This **generates compost** for volunteers to use onsite **returning nutrients** to the soil. A **liquid fertiliser** is also produced on the bottom layer which we can collect by tap. This liquid, when diluted with water, creates the perfect **natural feed** for our plants. Can you spot the green wormery onsite?

- Our Orchard: Thanks to our recent corporate volunteers joining us onsite mid-week, we have now planted the apple and pear trees donated to Compass by the Aberdeenshire project 'Social Juice' Our community orchard also extends along the south-facing wall with espalier and cordon varieties too.
- What's Growing at Compass: Svetislav has been busy creating a central herb area in Compass' community garden complete with a beautiful dry stone wall feature. Our volunteers have helped plant these with **lavender**, rosemary, thyme and more whilst also filling the no-dig beds with potatoes, strawberries and remaining fruit **bushes**. CWT Admin staff have also joined the team onsite to help with the next round of seed planting, their productive afternoon is pictured to the right.

Remember to bring cash if you'd like to take home any Compass items. We will have Compass trees, bushes and firewood available on a donation basis.


