Social Prescribing Services

Compass aims to encourage and support healthy, sustainable lifestyles. To progress this, we are developing a **Compass Social Prescribing Service**. Social prescribing is where healthcare professionals refer people to a range of non-medical support in the community to improve their health and wellbeing.

Our service will focus on **green social prescribing** – using our outdoor areas to help people improve their wellbeing through practical engagement with the natural world. We will pilot this service from early summer, with River Dee Medical Group and later expand to all GP practices in Lower Deeside, offering therapeutic gardening and outdoor experiences to those with health issues such as stress, anxiety and mild depression, alongside their other prescribed treatments. Research has shown that gardening and working outdoors can be hugely beneficial to improve physical and mental wellbeing. Feedback from our current wellbeing.
