About AnthroHealth

AnthroHealth is an extended and integrative approach based on conventional medicine.

It helps patients find new ways to:

- **address illness**
- **build resilience**
- **maintain wellbeing**

Our multidisciplinary AnthroHealth team work with patients to create individualised therapeutic programmes using:

- **AnthroMedicines:** based on natural substances [plant, mineral, metal and animal] and manufactured to pharmaceutical standards
- **External applications:** localised massage, compresses, baths
- **Therapies:** such as eurythmy therapy, a type of movement therapy

Our AnthroHealth approach engages patients as **active partners** in their own health. It takes into account physical, mental, emotional and personal factors that contribute to wellbeing.



Our areas of expertise

Our trained AnthroHealth team has particular expertise in the following areas:

What services are available?

We offer AnthroHealth:

- **doctor led clinics:** to plan your individual programme and to review your response.
- **nurse led clinics for:**
 - * external applications
 - * injections
 - * advice
- **therapies:** our AnthroHealth doctor will advise on the most appropriate for you.

Regular reviews will be carried out to monitor and optimise your programme.

Residential programmes, lasting one or two weeks in our onsite accommodation, are also available for those living at a distance.

Services not offered by CWT

CWT does not offer the following services:

- **Diagnosis or treatment for new conditions:** assessment / diagnosis should be carried out by your GP or other appropriate professional
- **Second opinion diagnoses**
- **Allergy or stool testing**
- **Natural Thyroid Hormone replacement**
- **Thyroxin prescriptions:**
e.g. for non-clinical thyroid conditions
- **Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT)**
- **Psychotherapy**
- **Classical homeopathy**
