
Buildings



- **Multi-Purpose Hall:** Refurbishment work of the Multi-Purpose Hall is due to start this April. We are aiming for an early Summer 2023 opening - get in touch if you are interested in hiring a space for your group: compass@cwt.scot
- **Kindergarten:** Visit our new Volunteer Hub to pick up your produce and seeds on a donation basis.
- Enterprise [Science] Block: Plans are underway as we design the locations of a smokery unit, Zero Waste kitchen and an extension of our Blue Door charity shop with restore and upcycle of larger items. Watch this space for future developments!

Outdoor Spaces

- **First seedlings head outside:** The growing season has officially started at Compass with the first seedlings being planted under the cold frames our team have constructed from spare materials onsite.
- **Removal of diseased trees:** Following tree management surveys, the **removal of diseased trees** is now being carried out to ensure these don't impact on the safe use of the site.
- Over 100 Woodland Trust Wild Harvest fruit and nut trees have arrived at Compass. We will be looking for volunteers to help plant the selection of hazel, blackthorn, crab apple, elder, dog rose and rowan at our next Saturday volunteer day, 1st April 2023. We look forward to the wild jellies and jams from these harvests
- Following the final dry stone walling session with local professional James Watt, **65 volunteers** have supported the restoration of **35m of wall** on our Compass site taking a combined total of **420 hours**.

Phase 1: achieved £200,000 Phase 2: ends September 2023 | Current amount raised: £881,283 | Target: £1.5 million

- Phase 2 Funding: Our next fundraising goal is to raise £1,500,000 by September 2023. We have raised an incredible £881,283* so far thanks to the support of grants and an anonymous donor. [*figure does not include lottery funding of £100,000 secured for next two years]
